Performing Arts Academy (PAA) Blackwood: At our Performing Arts Academy, MCA offers classes in acting, voice, musical theatre, and dance. On the first floor of the 19th century Performing Arts Academy, our lobby area, a classroom/flex space, and a lavatory are wheelchair accessible. School of Dance (SoD), Sewell / Washington Twp: At the School of Dance offers a variety of dance and movement classes. Our lobby, flex space, office, and main lavatory are wheelchair accessible. The two studios have raised dance floors. If this step is a challenge for a student, a class can be offered in our flex space.
